

Further to the charity's earlier RR, the trustees wish to add the following comments:

With reference to the relevant land plans (Document TR010065/APP/2.2 - page 15), we note that at the border between the "land to be permanently acquired" (coloured pink) and the land that remains in the ownership of the charity, a strip of land (6/2c) is identified as "land to be used temporarily and rights to be permanently acquired" (coloured blue). It is unclear to us why this is, so we seek an explanation as to what rights are to be permanently acquired and why.

We also expect that all borders between the permanent land take and the land owned by the charity will be marked by agricultural grade animal deterrent fencing and hedging and that the ongoing maintenance of such will be the responsibility of National Highways or another third party and not the responsibility of the charity."
