Please find below a summary of comments made by the Canal & River Trust in relation to ISH1 held on 3rd December 2024:

Issue 3

Article 58 Temporary Suspension of Navigation

The Canal & River Trust (the Trust) confirmed that significant progress had been made in respect of Article 58 and protective provisions for the Trust. New wording for Article 58 has recently been agreed with the applicant and the Trust confirmed that we understood this would be included in the draft DCO at Deadline 4.

Issue 5

Update on Protective Provisions

The Trust confirmed that there were only a few points outstanding between the applicant and the Trust on the draft protective provisions. As soon as the draft protective provisions have been agreed and included in the draft DCO, the Trust will be happy to confirm that there are no outstanding issues.

Other Comments

In response to the ExA's question about whether the Trust was in a position to withdraw its objection to compulsory acquisition powers to acquire land and rights from the Trust, the Trust confirmed that there had recently been significant progress in negotiations for land and rights. Accordingly, the Trust would maintain its objection on the basis that the applicant will be unlikely, by the end of the examination, to need compulsory acquisition powers in respect of Trust land.
