A46 Coventry junctions (Walsgrave)
**PLANNING ACT 2008 SECTION 46: DUTY TO NOTIFY SECRETARY OF STATE OF
PROPOSED APPLICATION**

I am hereby notifying you under Section 46 of the Planning Act 2008 that National Highways (“the applicant”) intends to apply under Section 37 of the Planning Act for a Development Consent Order (DCO) for the **A46 Coventry junctions (Walsgrave)**.

Consultation Information

National Highways will be undertaking statutory pre-application consultation under Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 between **Wednesday 25 October** and **Wednesday 6 December 2023**. Please find the documents listed in this letter in the shared OneDrive site, the link to which is in the accompanying email. All of the information that has been supplied to S42 prescribed consultees as part of this consultation is included on that channel. No Category 3 land interests have been identified at this stage, as there are no areas currently identified by the National Highways environment team where there is a significant increase in environmental factors which will be detrimental to land interests. If any Category 3 land interests are identified at a later stage, these land interests will be notified under Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008, and duly consulted via targeted consultation.
