

Description:

Ancient semi-natural Pedunculate Oak (Quercus robur)/Hornbeam (Carpinus betulus) coppice-with-standards woodland site largely replanted with conifers. Semi-natural broadleaved woodland remains as remnants of variable width around the perimeter. Additional woody species recorded include Beech (Fagus sylvatica), Ash (Fraxinus excelsior), Wild Cherry (Prunus avium) with much coppiced Hazel (Corylus avellana). The ground flora is quite diverse with Bluebell (Hyacinthoides non-scripta) dominant plus other species of note including Wood Sedge (Carex sylvatica), Yellow Archangel (Lamiastrum galeobdolon), Wood Melick (Melica uniflora), Wood Millet (Milium effusum), Wood Meadow-grass (Poa nemoralis) and Broad Buckler-fern (Dryopteris dilatata). Old pits and wood banks add to the habitat diversity. Wildlife Site criteria: Ancient Woodland Inventory site; remnant semi-natural canopy; ancient physical features; woodland indicators.
