1. I followed the open hearing on livestream yesterday evening and heard you ask Feroza Bartlett for details of the awards Wigmore Park had won. I am attaching herewith a picture of a display board which show both the 2019 and 2022 awards given by Fields in Trust.

2. Secondly, I was suprised by the justification given by the Integrated Care Board and the University of Bedfordshire in heavily supporting the airport expansion despite their own health research involvement. Namely the CHILL Study(Children's Health in London and Luton) a 4 year reseach study represented by Prof. Gurch Randhawa at the University of Bedfordshire along with an amalgam of London Universities and hospitals, (Kings College, UCLH, BARTS), as well as Cambridge, and Edinburgh Universities. This health study involved following children in primary schools looking at lung health in relation to pollution and used children in around 40 schools in Luton and surrounding areas.
