Note regarding the fire training process provided by the Applicant in writing to the Case Team on 23 November 2023

The deployment will be as follows:

- RFFS vehicles will wait at the approach road to the fire training ground. The fire training rig uses gas to simulate aircraft fires, such as an engine fire, undercarriage fire or fuel spill fire.
- A radio message will be issued describing the practise incident they are attending and they will respond accordingly.
- Firefighting will commence in line with training using the appliance equipment (a high reach turret used to fight fires) and high pressure hose reels for manual firefighting, if required.
- Once extinguished, the team will debrief and return to station. This is a training exercise and we will have trainees with us on the fireground.

It is worth noting we will not train with firefighting foam, we use water for environmental reasons.

The whole exercise should last about 15 minutes. If there are any questions on the day feel free to call. If there are any real incidents on the day that will delay this I will update you.
