One further document that is being submitted on LBC's behalf is the Statement of Common Ground, which is being uploaded by the Applicant.


Under separate cover we are submitting our update to the Principal Areas of Disagreement (PADSS).

Further meetings are lined up for next week in order to address some of the areas that are highlighted in our PADSS, and we hope that we will see some further resolution of outstanding issues.
