The Examining Authority (ExA) writes to the Applicant following their submission of 'Accounting for Covid-19 in Transport Modelling Final Report' [AS-159]. The ExA note that the Applicant commits to make additional submissions in respect of the noise and air quality assessments at Deadline 7 (D7) but has not provided a covering letter or email to explain the extent of any additional submissions or other steps that the Applicant may need to take in light of the findings of this report.

The ExA request that the Applicant submits a cover letter explaining the next steps, including timeframes, in more detail. Any submissions made at D7 should take into account the requirements of the ExA's further written questions and the new transport assessment information, to ensure that all D7 responses are as up to date as possible. On the basis that further noise and air quality information is to be submitted, the ExA also requires that the list of respondents to the ExA's further written question BCG2.13 is extended to include all Local Authorities as well as Highway Authorities.

The ExA requires responses on or before **Deadline 7** which is **Tuesday 9 January 2024**.
