I wish to refer to your letter dated 26th January 2024 and would wish to respond as follows

I have attended two Open Forum Meetings in regards of the above , the first and the third meeting. At the first meeting both Faith groups and charities spoke in support of the expansion , Their reasoning being that the expansion would lead to an increase in lucrative employment opportunities.

In a similar vane , at the third meeting , the head of Luton College and a representative from Luton Borough Council both spoke of the benefit of an increasing number of well paid , highly skilled employment resulting from the airport expansion .

Throughout these meetings , when the increase in employment was raised , no reference to Al/automation in the search for increased productivity and profit and the ensuing loss of jobs. In a recent study by the investment bank Goldman Sachs , it was estimated that more than 20% of the work in the world could be automated by AI by 2030, with the Western World being the most susceptible.
