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1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

- 1.1.1. This document has been prepared jointly by Hertfordshire County Council ("HCC"), Dacorum Borough Council ("DBC") and North Herts Council ("NHC") in collaboration with their technical consultants, together referred to as the "the Hertfordshire Host Authorities". The Examining Authority published a further request for further information and written comments under The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 (as amended) – Rule 17 on 31 January 2024.
