1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

1.1.1 London Luton Airport Limited, trading as Luton Rising (“the Applicant”), has applied to the Secretary of State for Transport for development consent under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (“the Act”).

1.1.2 The application is for an order granting development consent, known as a Development Consent Order (“DCO”). The draft DCO is referred to as the London Luton Airport (Expansion) Development Consent Order. The DCO, if granted, would authorise an increase of the permitted capacity of London Luton Airport (“the airport”) to 32 million passengers per annum (mppa) (“the Proposed Development”).

1.2 Purpose of this document

1.2.1 Statements of Common Ground (SoCGs) have been prepared and developed during the Examination by the Applicant and relevant Interested other pParties in line with the Rule 6 letter from the Examining Authority (ExA). The SoCGs provide a record of discussions to date with a number of key those Interested Parties and a summary of the matters that are either agreed, subject to ongoing discussion, or not agreed. Drafts of the SoCGs have been shared with the relevant Interested Parties and their comments addressed. ~~1.3.3 A change notification request was submitted to the Examining Authority on 22 September 2023 [REP4-031] to update the Drainage Design Statement, following ongoing engagement with Thames Water and the Environment Agency. The Examining Authority subsequently confirmed by way of a Rule 9 letter, issued on 13 October 2023, that the changes could be deemed non-material and accordingly could be accepted into the Examination, requesting that an updated Drainage Design Statement be submitted at Deadline 4. The Applicant submitted the updated Drainage Design Statement at Deadline 4 as requested by the Examining Authority (subsequently corrected at Deadline 5 [REP5-096]). The Environment Agency is currently reviewing the documents submitted at Deadline 4 and 5, and as such this iteration of the Statement of the Common Ground, does not fully take into account their current position on the proposal.~~
