Application by London Luton Airport Limited ("the Applicant") Seeking Development Consent for the Proposed London Luton Airport Expansion ("the Proposed Development").

CONSULTATION SEEKING COMMENTS FROM THE APPLICANT and ALL INTERESTED PARTIES

Following the completion of the Examination on 10 February 2024, the Examining Authority ("the ExA") submitted a Report and Recommendation in respect of its findings and conclusions on the above application to the Secretary of State for Transport on 10 May 2024. The Statutory deadline for this decision is now 4 October 2024 having been extended on 24 May 2024 by way of Written Ministerial Statement in accordance with section 107 of the Planning Act 2008.

INVITE TO COMMENT

On 2 August 2024 a <u>consultation</u>¹ on a number of outstanding issues was published seeking comments from the Applicant and a number of other Interested Parties. The deadline for response was 19 August 2024. The <u>representations received</u>² in response to the consultation have now been published and the **Applicant** and **all Interested Parties** are invited to provide any comments on them that they may wish to make. In particular, comments are invited from:

• **Natural England,** on the information contained in <u>the Applicant's letter dated</u> <u>19 August 2024</u> in relation to section 85 of the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000 (paragraphs 4.10 – 4.20).

It is noted that the Applicant will provide additional information in relation to engagement with Network Rail, Govia Thameslink Railway, and East Midlands Railway by 20 September 2024.

Deadline for Responses

The deadline for response is 6 September 2024.
