This year there has been an every increasing noise level from aircraft flying particularly low over the village of Clophill presumably from aircraft being held in a holding pattern.

This noise disruption seems to be more frequent from noon until midnight.

It interrupts my working indoors on the computer, on the 'phone, holding a conversation in the garden and has even awoken me after having retired for the day.

I understood that the present Luton Airport flite patterns avoided flying over Clophill. Surly Air Traffic Control should be ensuring the aircraft should either pass to the south of Silsoe or a mile north of Clophill not as I have watched, following the Village High Street seemingly heading towards the Clophill Roundabout on the A6.

If Air Traffic Control appears not to be able to control aircraft and ensure that the safety and quality of life for those living in villages we need to ensure there are adequate controls in place to oversee the present operation. I cannot possibly see how it can manage a material increase In passenger levels by up to two fold with a similar increase in aircraft movement.
