What is more shocking is that Luton Borough Council will expect the residents to pay for permits!

Luton Borough Council (LLA) need to find better ways to invest in the town (particularly its town centre and its youth) rather than using the airport. The expansion of the airport is actually, damaging and causing increase resentment in the local area, reducing value of homes for hard working class (council tax paying) people - all to create a service for people who do not spend their money in our town, but arrive and leave.
