**Subject:** Manston Airport Plans

We live in Herne Bay and are strongly against the redevelopment of Manston Airport for the following reasons:

- The regeneration and prosperity of the seaside towns in East Kent has been very noticeable in the last few years, attracting large numbers of people to live in the area as well as tourists and holidaymakers. A major new airport nearby, with flight paths over the towns, could well bring this to a halt and decimate the tourist trade.
- My house is right under the flight path for planes landing at Manston. In the past, the low number of planes passing overhead wasn't a problem but the noise and vibrations from a big increase in cargo and passenger planes, including night flights, would be intolerable.
