London and the surrounding area already has 5 airports, and the pressure on all of these is enormous. Manston, is in a unique geographical position to take some of that pressure, particularly European flights, charter flights and possibly freight. I now live in Deal, but previously lived in the [REDACTED] area of Ramsgate, and remember the daily flights coming into Manston.

The aircraft begin their descent well out over the sea, and approach low over the town, and land quite quickly with none of the holding or stacking systems incorporated over London and the surrounding counties. By the time the planes have landed in London, people arriving at Manston could be halfway up the M2, M20 or on a fast train to St Pancras or other London termini.

There would also be work opportunities for the East Kent area, already blighted by lack of same.

We some spending on transport connections to Motorways, and railway stations, Manston could be a thriving alternative to long waits in London.
