RSP's noise mitigation plan does not take into consideration the specifics of homes in Ramsgate. Their proposals for sound insulation and the associated costs simply do not recognise the conservation status and nature of historic buildings within the town. The cost of double-glazing of fairly standard Victorian properties not within conservation areas and not listed is typically over £10,000 and moving to over £20,000. Many properties in Ramsgate are much older and are listed meaning that straightforward double glazing is not even possible for these homes. The noise mitigation plan fails to recognise the specifics of the largest conservation area in Kent.
