Could you disclose what testing you do for the firefighting foam toxic legacy and the results of such tests and any problems re the chemicals being toxic below minimum detection threshold.

I have also asked TDC solicitor to expedite the Water Services answer via the water liaison arrangement of TDC.

I note too that while purporting to conduct a review of the ir contaminated land strategy TDC are laying off a valuable source in that regard their Coastal Protection Officer who collates and seeks the reports of eyes on the ground the volunteer coastal wardens. I myself have been trying to firm up evidence for a report of alleged Pfizer pharmaceutical waste in River Stour. As far as I know these people spotting this sort of thing are volunteers and I commend them.

I await a response to FOI from attorney general re terrorism law and Thanet history that relates to Sericol the company who contaminated water supply aquifer with cyclohexanone and has implications for the police inquiry into alleged Manston related fraud related to bypassing statutory duties in environment and public health protection. This FOI is about Attorney General Fiats in paramilitary and explosives laws and also about overseas mission sanctions. And I wait to see what develops. It is an FOI to be aware of.

In spite of the deadline afforded them by Information Commissioner TDC have defied the Information and still have not answered the FOIs of which you are already aware.
