Issue Specific Hearing 7 - Traffic& Transport

At the DCO hearing on 6th June 2019,

KCC requested that RiverOak fund a footpath / cyclepath from Manston Village to Manston Airport. Save Manston Airport association have attempted to find out if this would be cost effective.

We have contacted Manston Parish Council, as to how many of their residents would be likely to use the footpath; We believe that they are responding directly to the Inspectorate.

We have also now run a poll for one week, open to our 3,500 members, a significant number of whom worked at Manston, and/or who are hoping for employment there when it re-opens:

"If you live in Manston Village and are hoping to get a job at Manston Airport, would you most often walk / cycle / take the bus / drive to and from work?

"Alternatively, one more question, would you use the path for dog walking?"

The result after one week is:

- 11: I would instead use the path for dog walking
- 4: I hope to cycle to work from Manston Village to Manston Airport
- 2: I hope to walk to work from Manston Village to Manston Airport
- 1: I hope to drive to work from Manston Village to Manston Airport
- 0: I hope to take the bus to work from Manston Village to Manston Airport


