Dear Sir/Madam

I write to submit an objection to the DCO application from RSP Ltd. I am a resident of Ramsgate, and have lived in the area for at least five years. My objection is based on the following points:

1. My understanding is that the development order would lead to night flights, as RSP seek permission for night-time late arrivals, which would lead to unacceptable noise disruption to residents.
2. The general noise pollution would seriously damage the quality of life for local residents, with negative effects on physical and mental health. Disruption to schools and general education would also clearly follow from granting this application. Under the Human Rights Act, I understand that a full impact assessment must be undertaken, however the RSP noise contours are demonstrably inaccurate.
3. There is no 'national need', as both Stansted and East Midlands airports both have spare capacity. A third runway is also planned at Heathrow. Moreover, there is no economic justification for granting the airport, as it is simply not commercially viable. Local infrastructure is inadequate to support the facility and there are plans for its development.

For the above reasons, I would like to lodge my strong objection to this application.
