Dear Sirs

Having followed the DCO process since registering as an interested party I have tried to read, understand and comment on the application to the best of my ability.

However, the latest round of questions published by yourself last Friday runs to 178 pages.

The reason, as far as I can tell, the questions are 178 pages long is because:

- the Applicant has not provided all the information needed that had been asked for
- the applicant have failed to engage adequately with various interested parties

Either way, the information required is of such magnitude that I and other interested parties will simply not have the time or opportunity to digest and comment on all the information requested.

Which then begs the question - is the Applicant deliberately trying to run out of time and as a result can this examination be completed satisfactorily within the statutory examination period?

On the basis of the above sentence I would like this application to be refused as otherwise it would be an abuse of the DCO process.
