Dear Sirs,

Over the past few months I have tried to keep abreast of your enquire regarding consenting to a DCO for the Manston Airport site.

I have made time to attend sessions of your enquire in Margate, Ramsgate and Sandwich.

I now find myself confronted by a 178 page document presented at the last moment by the applicant RSP.

It is not possible for me as a member of the public, whose house is located directly under the flight path and therefore a person with a genuine reason to challenge RSP, to read through such a large document at such short notice.

I genuinely believe that the presentation of such a large document at a time when the enquiry is almost closed is not an acceptable way for a legitimate company to conduct its business.

I cannot see how any legal enquiry conducted over many months can accept a document from RSP that appears to have been deliberately held back until your enquiry was almost completed.

I therefore request that the application be refused as it appears to be an attempt by RSP to subvert the workings of PINS enquiry.
