You appear to be asking for a lot more details from Riveroak, of which we approve as everything seems up in the air with no concrete figures
Is it possible that all this can be supplied and digested within the time limit, and we will not have time to read digest and comment on it all.
It is our opinion that the ExA must refuse the application as this would be an abuse of the DCO process.

We were aware that we chose to purchase our bungalow on a flight path which did day flights only, except emergencies at night which rarely happened and we did not mind.
Day flights apart from the noise and pollution can be tolerated but flights after say 20.00hrs would ruin lives of our family, young and old as well as ourselves and our neighbours. The effects of lack of sleep and stress is one we would not want to consider. All this will destroy the quality of life we have come to love and enjoy and all the health benefits of living by the sea would be negated.
Has anyone considered that if this number of flights arrive all the goods would have to be transported by lorries on the already over stretched roads?.
