Dear Madam

I live in Ramsgate, off the London Road, probably less than a mile from the ex-Manston Airport. When planes flew during the day, it was extremely noisy. As you might imagine, I've been enjoying the recent quiet!

I have already written in to explain why I don't want the airport to re-open. If it does, I definitely don't want night flights - scheduled or chartered. I understand that RSP has said it will not need night flights. In that case, it doesn't need to have any QC written into the DCO.

Of course, if you give permission for this to return to an operating airport, I understand that any emergency or humanitarian flights are not included in a QC count so these, if they are ever needed, would of course be acceptable night flights.
