

**MANSTON AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER EXAMINATION
SUBMISSION TO DEADLINE 9:
Comments on Information requested by the ExA and received from the
Applicant to Deadline 8
and
Comment on DCO 4.1- Requirement 1**

1. We make comment on the following proposed wording within Article R1 by the Examining Authority without prejudice to any other wording in the DCO.
2. We have provided evidence within our Submission at Deadline 9¹ that R1 – Interpretation should reflect the fleet mix that was assessed in the ES and the Second draft DCO definition of “**General Aviation**” be amended as follows:

*“General Aviation movement means landings or take-off of **light aircraft operations to be limited to Single Propellor and Small Twin Piston light aircraft, for example Piper PA28 and PA34, other than scheduled air services and nonscheduled air transport operations for remuneration or hire**” (bold added for emphasis).*
2. We respectfully support the following definitions within **PART 1 REQUIREMENTS** as provided by the Examining Authority:

R1

1. In this Schedule— “**Bellyhold**” means the cargo hold of a passenger aircraft used for freight

“**Cargo Air Transport Movement**” means landings or take-offs of aircraft engaged on the transport of freight or mail on commercial terms. All scheduled movements, including those operated empty and loaded charter movements are included, but passenger flights carrying bellyhold freight are not included.

“habitable” means a room used, or intended to

“Passenger Air Transport Movement” means landings or take-offs of aircraft engaged on the transport of passengers on commercial terms. All scheduled movements, including those operated empty, loaded charter and air taxi movements are included.

“Scheduled” means planned according to a schedule and includes both scheduled and chartered flights.
