Every one of those teenagers appeared to be fine and well and had obviously not had their education affected by low flying aircraft coming into Manston over Ramsgate, as they had all passed the Kent Test and were local grammar school pupils! Unless Manston Airport reopens, those same teenagers - and many more - will probably have to move away once they finish university, as there are very few jobs here, currently. Just a thought...
