Dear Sir/Madam

I am a local resident and object to the Development Consent Order application by Riveroak Strategic Partners.

My reasons for the objection are many some of which are stated below.

#### Night Flights

Permission for "late arrivals" means this is unacceptable and disruptive to sleep and must be turned down.

#### Noise Pollution

This is damaging to both physical and mental health and disrupts education.

The Human Rights Act says we are all entitled to respect for our private and family life and enjoyment of our homes and anyone making a decision that interferes with this (eg by granting a DCO) must show that those affected have had full information on its impact and the chance to object. RSP's information on noise contours is inaccurate, so the information available from them does not pass the test.

I remember what it was like when Manston was an airport with the planes flying so low you felt you could touch the plane and the noise was terrible and the whole house shook. RSP plan 29 times as many flights as Manston ran previously using older and noisier planes.

Other reasons include air pollution which would affect among others are the children.

The extra costs to homeowners trying to soundproof their homes which would not be cheap as a lot of buildings are listed.

Also no extra jobs would be created as cargo is mainly automated.

I hope you will give these objections a lot of thought.
