

Following the disastrous unexpected news that RSP have secured the purchase of Manston Airport site from Stone Park ahead of a the long awaited and expected refusal of government decision about the Compulsory Purchase of the site to use as a Cargo Hub.

To bear that there is a likelihood of this acti-social, seti-environmental and bealth endangering proposal being granted, Ramagate residents are again faced with a new diluman, that of being denied adequate compensation for the noise level of 6MB when London and City airports have made compensations at 54B.
