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Subject: Airport compensation plans.
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Following the disastrous unexpected news that RSP have secured the purchase of Manston Airport site from Stone Park ahead of a long awaited and expected refusal of government decision about the Compulsory Purchase of the site to use as a Cargo Hub.

To hear that there is a likelihood of this anti-social, anti-environmental and health endangering proposal being granted; Ramsgate residents are again faced with a new dilemma, that of being denied adequate compensation for the noise level of 63dB when London and City airports have made compensations at 57dB.

The diagram showing compensation zones makes it almost impossible to see which homes are eligible. Yet again confusion and suspicion surrounds everything to do with RSP and the uncertainty of Nethercourt Hill residents quality of life is still in jeopardy. We personally are right under the flight path and could see the planes landing on the runway.

We hope you will uphold the sound level compensation limits that London and City airports have used in the event that permission is given for the re-opening of Manston as an Airport despite the wishes and evidence of unviability.
