It clearly states in your own website;

It appears that you have reneged on this principle by allowing questions regarding the airport to be accepted after the statutory deadlines, which are there to preclude any more debate on the DCO taking place. This is therefore a clear contravention of your mandate and could be seen as a delaying tactic.
