Thanet is an area that fails to attract any significant inward investment, and this has resulted in a high level of unemployment (9.4%). The proposal by River Oak to develop Manston Airport as a cargo hub and associated infrastructure will be a shot in the arm in terms of local employment, and it will also have the effect of attracting further inward investment from the aviation and freight sector.

Since the sale of the airport we residents have been bombarded by an extremely vocal minority of those not supporting the reopening and development.
