FAO of Manston Airport Case Team - Request, For Further Comments regarding the DCO for Manston:

I write as a former member of the Manston Airport Consultative Committee (MACC) and the Kent International Airport Consultative Committee (KIACC).

Both of the above were a statutory body set up by the Government to liaise and deal with issues pertaining to Manston Airport.

I am still somewhat bewildered that your department has ignored the Planning Inspectorates advice - and further to this putting the onus on the local community to put into writing, "what has changed"! This clear and wilful disregarding of a community to look after developers interests above the wider communities, of which was acknowledged by the Exa in its deliberation. It should be perfectly obvious to your department whats changed? For brevity I will state the obvious ones:-
