I am writing once again with regards to the proposed development of Manston Airport following the news that the latest report (like every other) has found the airport to be non-viable.

As a resident living in Ramsgate and under the proposed flight path I have concerns for my own and the community's health & wellbeing as a result of the subsequent increase in pollution & noise levels directly over the town and its surrounding villages. I also fear that this will increase road congestion and pollution & set a precedent for further expansion.

Ramsgate's future is held in the balance. It is a town which holds great cultural heritage and relies upon tourism, hospitality and its fine beach. This would all be blighted by the proposed 10,000 cargo flights a year flying in at low altitude over the beach, Royal Harbour and town, to land at Manston (a mere 2 miles away).
