Good morning,

Further to your request for further comments following following the conclusion by the aviation expert that the Secretary of State appointed that there was no need or requirement for a cargo hub at Mansion Airport. All the expert advice advised against it. It is very good news for the residents of Ramsgate.

It would be a travesty if a political decision is made to ignore the decision of two sets of experts and the views of the thousands of Ramsgate residents who live below and close to the flight path. As I stated before I am Director of Sion House Management Co. and represent the Residents of [REDACTED] and our neighbours.

The Secretary of State appointed a group of four very experienced Planning Inspectors and an experienced Aviation Consultant to advise on this matter. All, for a variety of reasons opposed this development the main reasons were:-

- 1/ The effect on the residents living under and close to the flight path also the effect this would have on the schools.
- 2/ The effect it would have on the Government's attempts to reduce the effects of global warming.
- 3/ The effect of these flights on air pollution and the wellbeing of children.
- 4/ There is no need commercially for this development.

I would finally ask the Secretary of State to consider the the effects of this proposal on the lives, jobs, health and wellbeing of the people of Ramsgate.

I look forward to hearing the result of the Secretary of State's decision.
