I am sending this email as I believe the amount of changes that have taken place since the application was made, should now be taken into consideration.

1. The flight path the planes take when coming in to land is across the main beach at a very low level.

The Royal Pavilion is now a bar with a large roof top terrace, which we would not be to use due to the noise level. With out the planes Ramsgate has seen a large increase in the number of businesses along the sea front that now bring a lot more people into the town. Plus their has been a large devolvement of flats and a hotel, I can see these being left empty and with people put off visiting the businesses would become run down.

2. The housing that was due to go on the airport as now been planned to be built on grade A farm land this can't be right.
