There are so many reasons why this venture should be finally discarded and the Independent Aviation Assessor's findings be upheld. No significant or material changes since 2019 application to give support to proposed development. Global warning issues and regulations have come into place recently which have altered the aviation industry's future usage of passenger and cargo transfer. Cargo needs can be absorbed into existing UK airports capacity.

Factual reasons against-

1. The location of the airport and road infrastructure doesn't make it viable for heavy transport vehicles.
2. Pollution factors, discharging over heavily populated housing area with the runway being too close to Nethercourt area housing.
3. Air quality, pollution factor from aviation fuel deposits.
4. Disturbance and interference with quality of life and more importantly likely deteriorating health issues.
