Good afternoon Max thank you for your confirmation.

RSP & groups like SMAa have made a big thing about tourists landing at Manston & getting boats up the Thames to use the London Resort as a reason for passing the DCO. At present neither the boats or resort exist. Looking at PINS website this morning we see that the London resort have withdrawn their DCO application. While at some point they may reapply there is nothing to say they will or the project will even move forward. Given this situation we feel that none of the evidence submitted with regard to the impact it could have on need at Manston should be considered by the DfT/SoS as relevant.

We realise the deadline has passed but this has only been announced today, March 29, on PINS web site and we feel it should be pointed out to the DfT/SoS in the redetermination of the Manston DCO.

We believe that the withdrawal by the London Resort was made before the March 28 deadline & only posted today and as it is less than 24 hours since the March 28 deadline has passed we hope this will be considered
