Summary of key points discussed and advice given:

The Planning Inspectorate advised that a note of the meeting would be taken and published on the National Infrastructure webpage in accordance with s51 of the Planning Act 2008.

Project update

An update was provided in respect of the Applicant's preparations to submit its application. The Applicant has considered the transitional provisions set out in the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulation 2017 (the 2017 Regulations) and whilst it considers that the transitional provisions apply to the application, the Applicant has decided to carry out a further round of statutory consultation under the 2017 Regulations, to ensure that the application is as robust as possible. The Applicant stated that the consultation documents would set out its position on the baseline assumed in terms of flight numbers for the purposes of the capability test set out in the Planning Act 2008.

The further round of consultation would take place over four to six weeks in January and February 2018, with the submission of the application anticipated to be in March 2018. The Applicant summarised that the consultation materials would include an updated full Preliminary Environmental Information Report which would satisfy the

2017 Regulations and also articulate how the application has developed since the previous statutory consultation in June and July 2017. Two consultation events would take place in Ramsgate and Herne Bay.
