Dear Sir/Madam.

I note that a site visit will be made at Gatwick Airport on Thursday 7th March '24 with regard to the Development of the Northern Runway.

I live opposite the existing runway to the South side at Lowfield Heath. Can I request that the site visit team looks at the close proximity of the Houses and Nursery School opposite the runway at Lowfield Heath - Poles Lane and along the Charlwood Rd.

We are small group of Houses and need to be considered. We feel we will be blighted by the increase in the level of noise from Aircraft - Taxiways take offs and landings. The Airport will double in size. The people who would have been able to sell their properties will not be able to do so with such a large Airport as their neighbour. If the Airport is developed further.

I have spoken with the Management team at the Airport they have said I have to prove Blight. They advised me to get legal representation.

I am an [REDACTED] year old widow I cannot afford the expense of legal representation. I have not got the energy to do battle with a Multi National company who have little regard for its neighbours.

I can only appeal to your team to take a look at the close proximity of the end of Poles Lane and Charlwood Rd properties in Lowfield Heath. The Airport management say we will not be affected by their future plans.
