Following the modification of the flight path coming in to land when there is an east wind in 2013/14, life in our home of then 30 years was made distressing by the roaring of aircraft overhead. This change was made without any consultation with the people on the ground who have to suffer the unreasonable amount of noise. I made my life here in Kirdford and Gatwick airport has made it utterly miserable on lovely summer days. I am too old to move and start again so have decided to remain in my home, of now over 40 years, despite the aircraft problem.

Now, after a government inquiry which concluded that if there were to be another major runway for London, it should be Heathrow. The decision was that there should be no further runway. Global warming is now a major issue and the air travel industry is a major contributor. Gatwick airport continues to want to increase the number of flights and with another runway the problem is likely to double.

The motivation for the expansion is greed. The developers simply do not care about their children and grandchildren inheriting a poisoned world. I know I do but most people don't feel able to respond as it feels utterly futile as there is no indication that our views are ever taken into account.

The reason for another runway at Gatwick is solely greed. More profits for the shareholders. The company might say they are providing jobs etc but there is no mass unemployment. The south east is fully employed. People would need to be brought in from other parts of the country. Does Gatwick think they are doing the area a favour?? I don't think so. I don't think I am overly cynical. The motivation is profit, never mind that it's poisoning the world and making millions of lives miserable in the process.

I object 100% to another runway being developed at Gatwick. The world and our personal environment will be better off with fewer planes not more.
