As a construction company the local supply chain is of paramount importance and if this scheme is allowed to proceed this will enhance the local economy and employment opportunities.

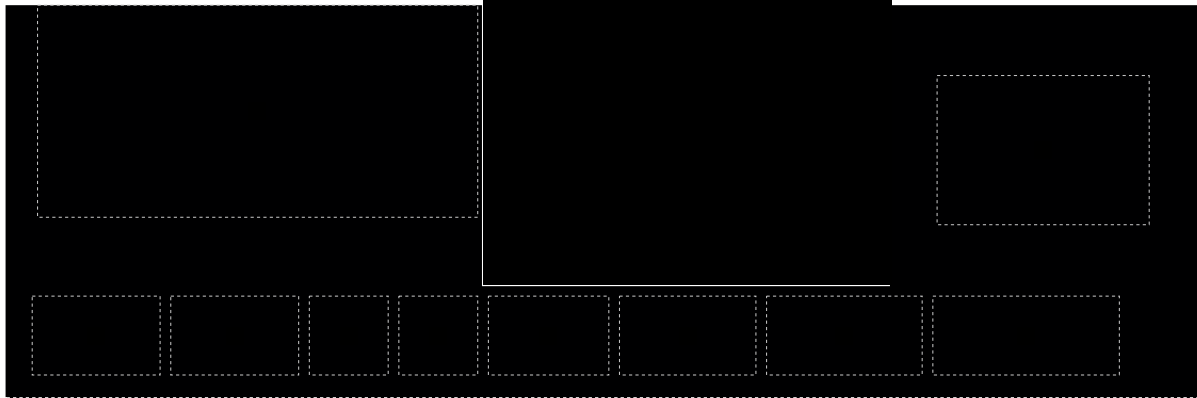
As a local resident living in Horsham for the last 17 years and with a strong sense of community, I have also experienced the benefits to our town parallel to steady growth at Gatwick over the years.
