Last summer (2023) there were severe limitations put on the use of Gatwick airport (https://metro.co.uk/2023/07/10/easyjet-1700-gatwick-flight-cancellations-19097047/) Not only do flights to and from Gatwick use this airspec but also flights and from Heathrow, Luton and Stanstead. Please consider the restrictions on airspace as part of your enquiry, it would be a shame to waste £2.2bn, especially as the UK has a history of cost overruns.
