As Interested Party 2004193 I would like to submit the following response to question CC2.1.

As a consequence of the Supreme Court Ruling concerning the issue of planning permission for the drilling of new oil wells at Horsehill I would like the following points to be considered by the planning inspectorate.

It is now widely accepted that scope 3 emissions have to be considered as an integral part of any development. The inevitability of these is no longer in doubt and so cannot be ignored as previously. Therefore I would like to planning inspectorate to look at all assessments of emissions and in particular the increased emissions resulting from increased flights into and out of Gatwick following expansion. Also in the absence of an efficient network of public transport the emissions from travel to and from the airport which is in excess of current journeys.
