I strongly oppose the development of a new runway at Gatwick Airport for the following reasons:

- A new runway does not comply national policy in 'Beyond the Horizons Making Best Use of Existing Runways'.
- The DCO has not addressed the issue of aircraft noise adequately. There should be a night ban on flights and a 0.5 decibel annual reduction in the noise envelope, as proposed by PINS.
  A Carbon Cap is needed to control Gatwick Airport's emissions. This should include the full range of emissions e.g.
- extra travel of passengers and workers to the airport and transport of goods and waste from the airport.
- Legally binding air quality standards are needed.
- The impact on Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty (ANOB) and of historic importance is not addressed. •
