I send this as today is the deadline set by the Panel for the submission of statements if common ground.

You will want to know that over the past months Capt. Cowing has been in regular contact with Able, who have provided information about their scheme. As a result, it has been possible to reach conclusions about issues of concern to the Harbour Master. However, that is still incomplete and is anyway a sufficiently recent development that it is not possible today to produce a meaningful SoCG. Discussions are continuing in the hope (and I can say for the Harbour Master the expectation) that a SoCG will be forthcoming before too long.
