

## Application for Development Consent - Able Humber Ports The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010

I write on behalf of my client Associated British Ports in connection with your request for further information under Rule 17.

In your letter of 2 November, you seek clarification of the Applicant's comments made in relation to the status of my client's landholding which will form part of the Western Deepwater Jetty.

For your assistance, you should be aware that there is no defined statutory boundary for the landward side of the harbour. The Triangle of land was acquired by ABP's predecessors, the British Transport Docks Board - as already explained in the representations of Mr John Fitzgerald submitted on 29 June 2012. The land is held by ABP for the purposes of its statutory undertaking and will be used for the purposes of its statutory undertaking.



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
