Application by Able Humber Ports Limited for consent from the Secretary of State to extend a time limit in the Able Marine Energy Park Development Consent Order 2014 (S.I. 2014/2935) under article 7 of this order

On the 18 December 2013, the Secretary of State (SoS) for the Department of Transport (DfT) granted development consent for the Able Marine Energy Park Development Consent Order (DCO), that came into force 29 October 2014.

We, are writing to you and/or your organisation as a potential consultee with interest regarding the Able Marine Energy Park project.

In October 2023, Able Humber Ports Limited ('the Applicant') made an application to the Secretary of State for Transport for the power to grant an extension to the Able Marine Energy Park DCO. In May 2024, the Applicant gave notice of the application to extend the time limit granted by the SoS regarding this DCO. This gave a deadline for responses by 21 June 2024 and following receipt of these responses, the SoS invited the Applicant to respond.
