Notice to Mariners – Notice issued that advises mariners of important matters affecting navigational safety.

Includes any notice to mariners which may be issued by the Admiralty, Trinity House, Queens harbourmasters, government departments and harbour and pilotage authorities.

WGS84 – (World Geodetic System 1984) is an Earth-centred, Earth-fixed terrestrial reference system and geodetic datum. A co-ordinate system used by MMO in all applications.

There is no definition for appropriately trained personnel, MMO conclude this can be removed.
