**THE YORK POTASH HARBOUR FACILITIES ORDER 201X**

We refer to the above and to our representation dated 4 June 2015.

As previously advised, we have been in close discussions with the Applicant for some time and we believe that agreement with the Applicant in respect of Northumbrian Water Infrastructure and interests is imminent.

We are therefore able to confirm that, subject to the completion of that agreement, we hope to be in a position to withdraw our representation to the Application shortly.

Again, subject to completion of that agreement, we hope to be able to confirm that we are satisfied with the proposed southern route for the conveyer. We also note the intended demolition of the jetty.
