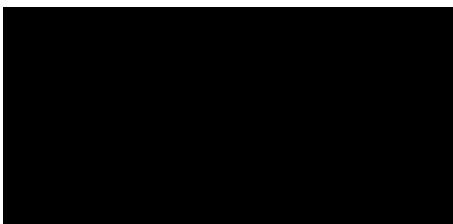
**PROPOSED YORK POTASH HARBOUR FACILITIES
